The Tennessee Heritage Barbecue Festival is a community event sponsored by the *Sam Davis Home* to celebrate the culturally diverse and rich heritage of Tennessee. The Festival will host an annual **barbecue cook-off** to celebrate the cuisine of fine barbecued meat. The categories of meat will include: Chicken, Pork Rib, Beef Brisket and Pork.

The **cooking teams or individual cooks** will declare themselves as **professional or backyard masters** (amateur) cooks. Each declared cooking category is accompanied by a different application fee, therefore; no team may enter more than one cooking category. **Professional cooks** will pay an application fee of **\$225.00** and **Backyard cooks** an application fee of **\$100.00**. The **backyard** cook off will only include pork ribs and chicken. **Professional cooks** must enter the four required categories of meat required by the Kansas City BBQ Society (chicken, pork ribs, pork, and beef brisket) to be eligible for the **Grand Champion and Reserve Champion** awards.

THE CONTEST

Teams or individuals may cook with any type of wood and/or charcoal. Other flammables (propane, compressed or liquid gas, etc.) may be used within the cooker only to start the Initial fire. No type of flammable other than wood or charcoal may be used within the cooker once the meat has been placed there.

Flammables may be used outside and away from the cooker to make additional coals. Local fire and safety laws may prevent the use of any type of gas anywhere on the grounds at any time, and, if so, these laws prevail.

2. Electrical devices may be used within the cooker as long as they do not directly generate heat. Approved devices include rotisseries, fans and delivery systems for approved fuels. Electric smokers, holding ovens or containers or any devices with heat producing electrical coils are not allowed.
3. All meat must be cooked on-site at the contest from a raw state whether fresh or frozen. Meat may not be pre-cooked, sauced, injected, marinated, cured in any way, or otherwise pre-treated prior to the official meat inspection. All meat must be maintained at a temperature below 40 degrees Fahrenheit prior to cooking, and at or above 140 degrees during and after cooking.
4. The **judging** of all categories of meat will be based upon the rules and regulations of the Kansas City Barbeque Society.

Contestant Responsibilities

Each contestant competing shall supply **all** of his own meat, cooking ingredients, individual cooking devices (portable stoves, wood, or charcoal, etc., No Gas) utensils, preparation tables, etc.

The only thing provided to the contestant is a regulation size cooking area and Styrofoam trays for submission during the judging process. All contestants **must** adhere to all electrical, fire, and other codes set forth by local governing authorities. **Fire extinguisher(s) will be required at ALL team sights (new for 2008). Proof of Fire extinguisher(s) will be required at meat inspections.**

Water and Electricity

Water will be available in selected locations. You will be required to have in your area a bucket of chlorinated water for sterilization. Please bring bleach for this. Electrical hookups are by request and will be available on a first come/first served basis. **Electrical hookups are NOT guaranteed to be available to the Backyard Team Division area.**

Acceptance

- **Application: \$225.00** entry fee for KCBS Professional Teams, and **\$100.00** for amateur/backyard teams is required with the submission of entry form. We will accommodate cooking rigs and trappings based on space availability. 20' x 30' foot frontage or larger will be at the discretion of the contest committee on a first come first served basis.
- Checks should be made payable to the **Sam Davis Home**. No refunds will be made once your application is accepted. If your application is not accepted, a full refund will be made to you.

NOTE: We accept VISA and MasterCard. Call Anita Teague at (615) 459-2341 to pay entry fee by phone.

- The **Deadline** to enter the cook off contest is **June 1, 2008**. Applications are accepted on a **first come first served bases**.
- Due to limited space, all entries submitted are not guaranteed entrance to the contest. **Enter Early!**

Within **ten** days of receipt of valid application with the appropriate fees, written acceptance or none acceptance will be given to the designed chief cooks.

THE BARBECUE STEERING COMMITTEE RESERVES THE RIGHT TO MAKE ADDITIONAL REGULATIONS AS THE SITUATION WARRANTS. ALL DECISIONS OF THE BARBECUE CHAIRMAN, COMMITTEE AND JUDGES ARE FINAL.

VIOLATIONS OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE CONTEST MAY RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION, EXPULSION FROM THE GROUNDS AND /OR THE DISQUALIFICATION FROM FUTURE PARTICIPATION.
